### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### **What's the survey about?**

This survey addresses the question of how the experience of living in different places affects your political attitudes. You will be asked questions about a variety of political and social issues. We are studying LDS missionaries before and after serving missions.

#### **How long will it take to answer?**

About 25 minutes, depending on your answers and the speed of your internet connection.

#### **What if I cannot access the survey?**

#### **Why did I get this email?**

All single students who are currently enrolled at BYU and are of common mission age received this email. You may also have friends that referred you to the study, or could have been contacted by a professor at a partnering university.

#### **Who is conducting this survey?**

This survey is being conducted by researchers at Stanford University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and Brigham Young University.

#### **Are my answers confidential?**

#### **Do I have to participate in this survey?**

No. Your participation is completely voluntary. You may skip any question in the survey by using the navigation buttons at the lower right of each screen.

#### **What are my odds of winning the gift card?**

The odds of winning depend on how many students complete the survey. The name of each person who completes the survey will be entered into the drawing one time. There will be multiple \$100 gift cards distributed in April, August, and December for those who take the Pre-Mission Survey. Completing the Post-Mission Survey upon return from your mission will qualify you for a \$500 gift card drawing.
